

CONFLICT OF INTEREST

Conflicts of interest have the potential to cause legal problems as well as embarrassment for CAHA and USA Hockey. While transactions involving conflicts of interest are not prohibited, they must be duly considered by the CAHA Executive Committee, based on disclosures as may be required by CAHA.

The conflict of interest policy defined in the USA Hockey Annual Guide is intended to help directors, officers, and certain other persons identify situations that present possible conflicts of interest and to provide a procedure whereby such potential conflicts may be reviewed by an appropriate party when necessary. CAHA has adopted USA Hockey conflict of interest policy and CAHA Executive Committee Members shall provide, in writing, acknowledgment of conflict of interest policy.
